

Skoda Superb offers more rear legroom than a Mercedes S Class at just £17,455

Škoda first used the Superb name back in 1934 and no car has been more deserving of the title than the current model. The winner of TopGear Magazine's Luxury Car of the Year Award, it offers more rear legroom than a Mercedes S Class and prices start from just £17,455 for the 1.4 TSI 122PS S.

Thirteen engines are available, five petrol and eight diesel, ranging from the 1.4TSI 125PS to the 2.0 TDI CR 170PS 4x4 DPF and it is available in S, SE, Elegance and Greenline trim.

Joining the hatchback with its revolutionary Twindoor boot, 2010 saw the launch of the Superb Estate, which, according to Autocar, has more room in it than most London flats; 1,865 litres of load space to be exact.

Both Superb and Superb Estate are available with manual or twin-clutch DSG gearboxes. It comes as either a standard two wheel drive or as a fourth-generation Haldex clutch four-wheel drive, which offers award winning comfort and safety, whatever the weather.

Superb GreenLine uses a 1.6 TDI CR 105bhp engine and produces just 114g/km of CO₂ and 64.2mpg combined thanks to improved aerodynamics and low resistance tyres.
